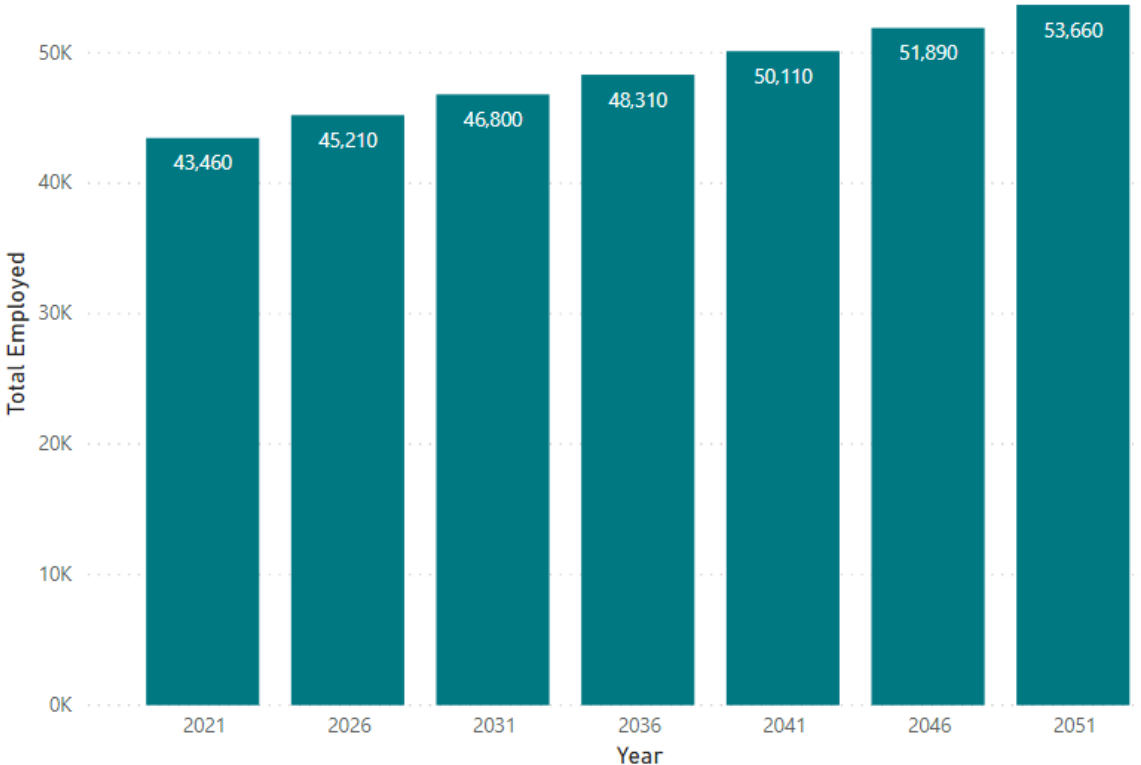

Grey County Employment Projection, 2021 - 2051

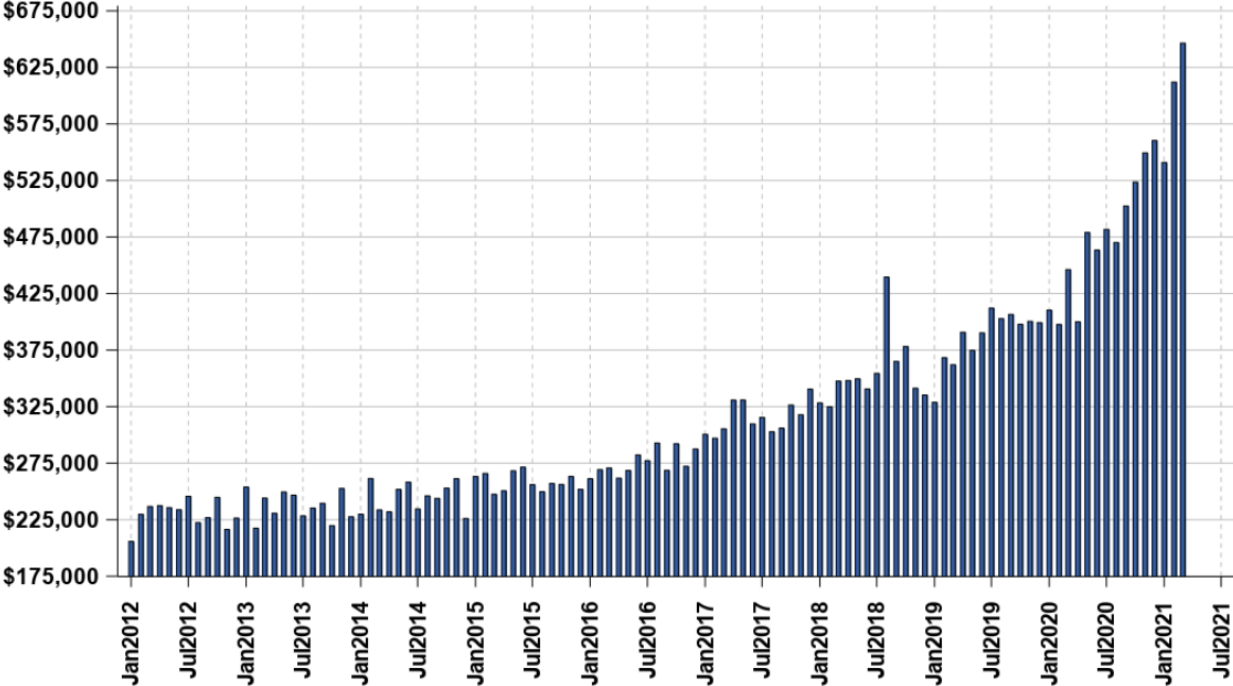

First time for dedicated student & seasonal virtual job fair held on April 7th, 2021.

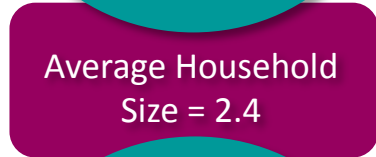
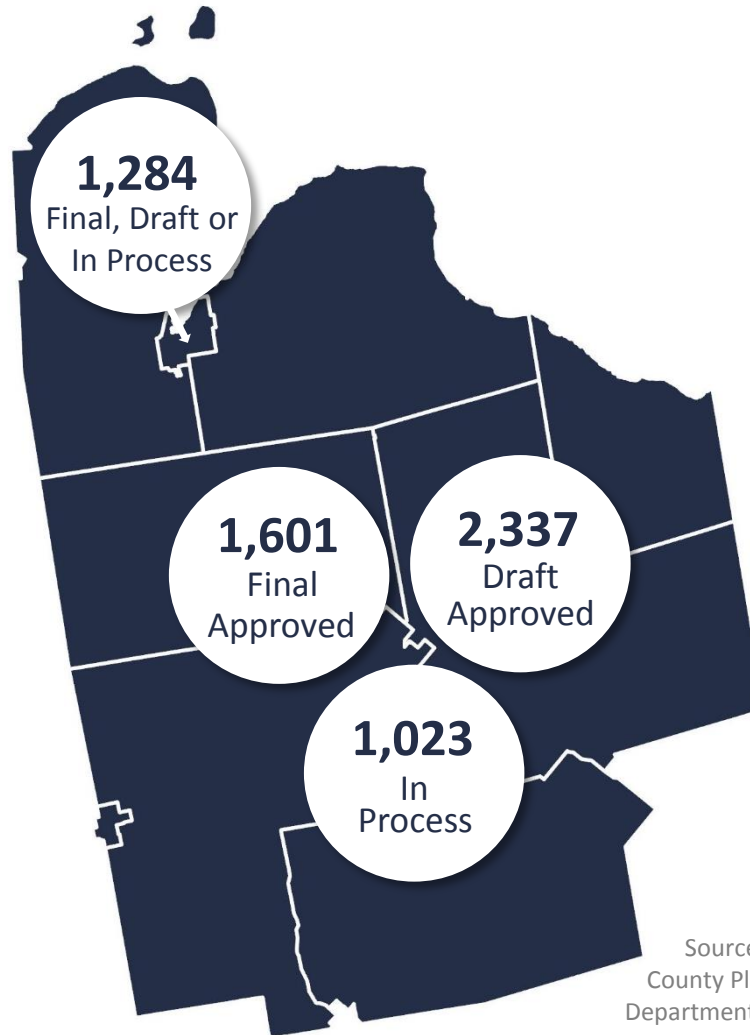
Employers

- 50% of students –very satisfied with virtual job fair

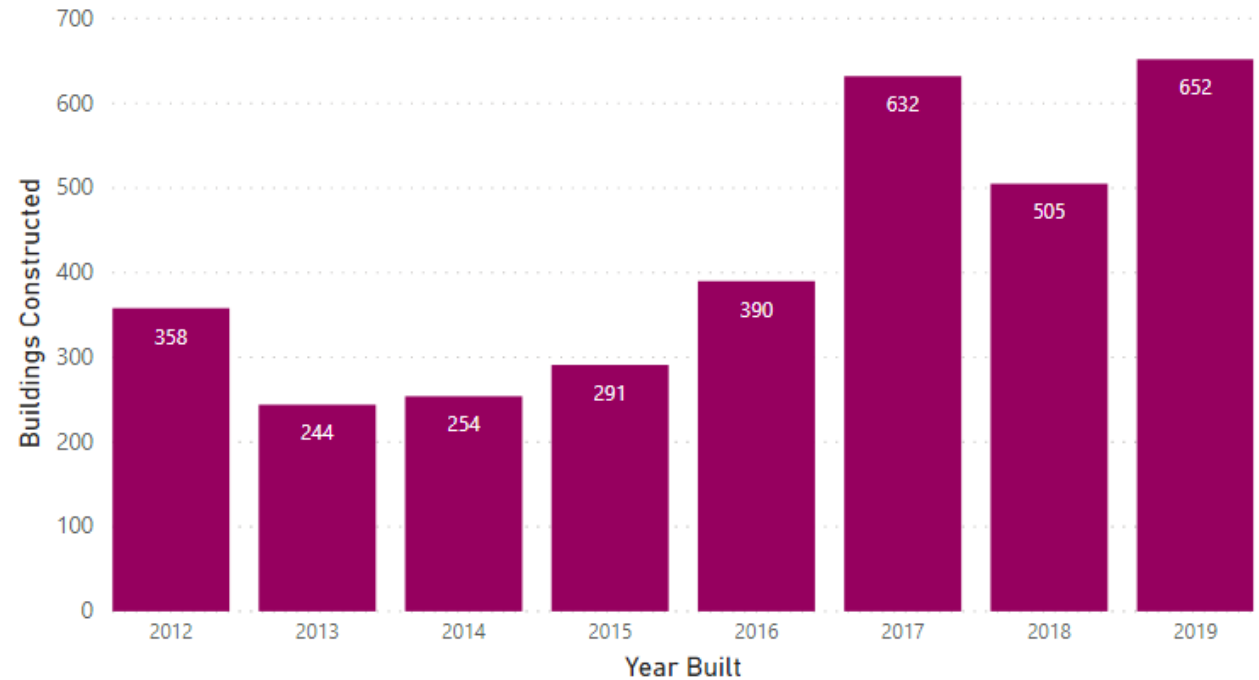

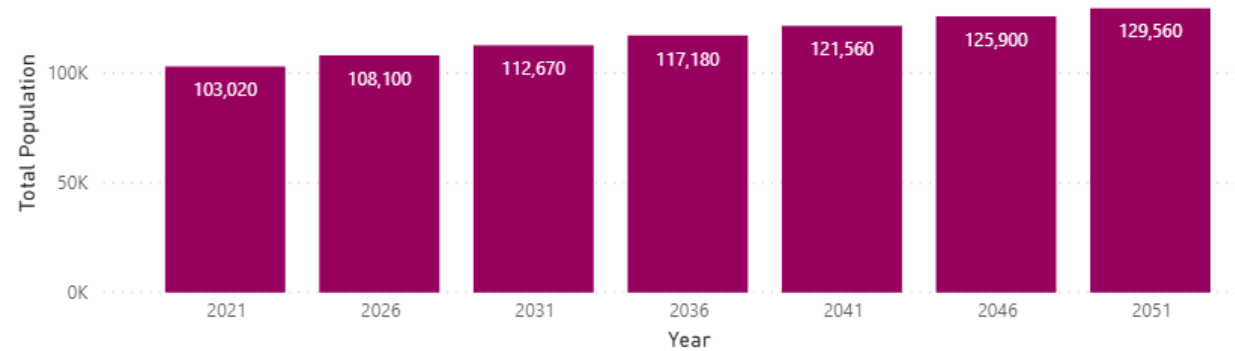
Grey County Construction By Year



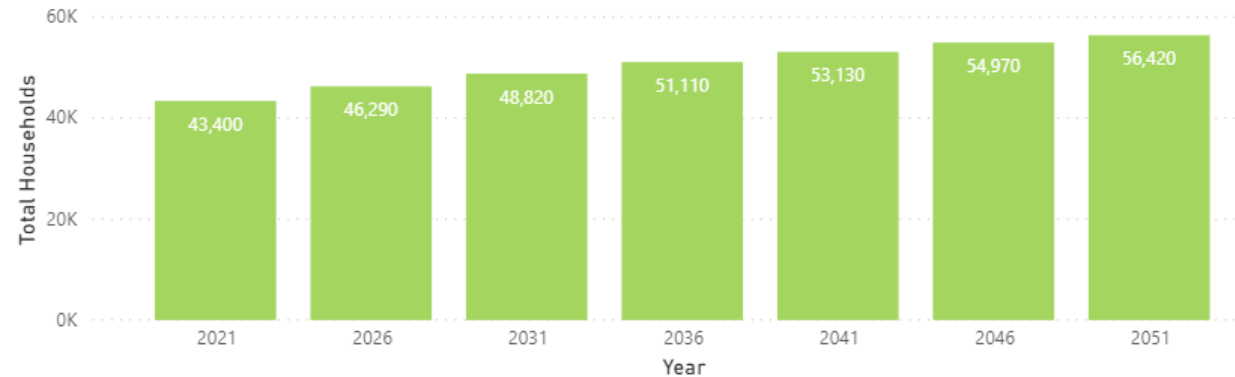

● 0-4 ● 5-9 ● 10-14 ● 15-19

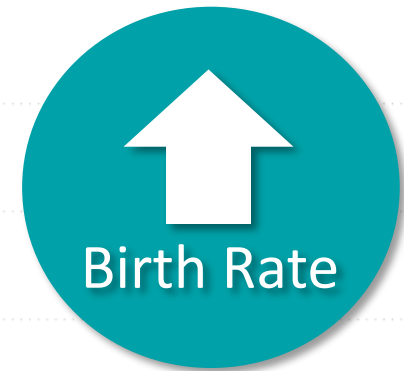
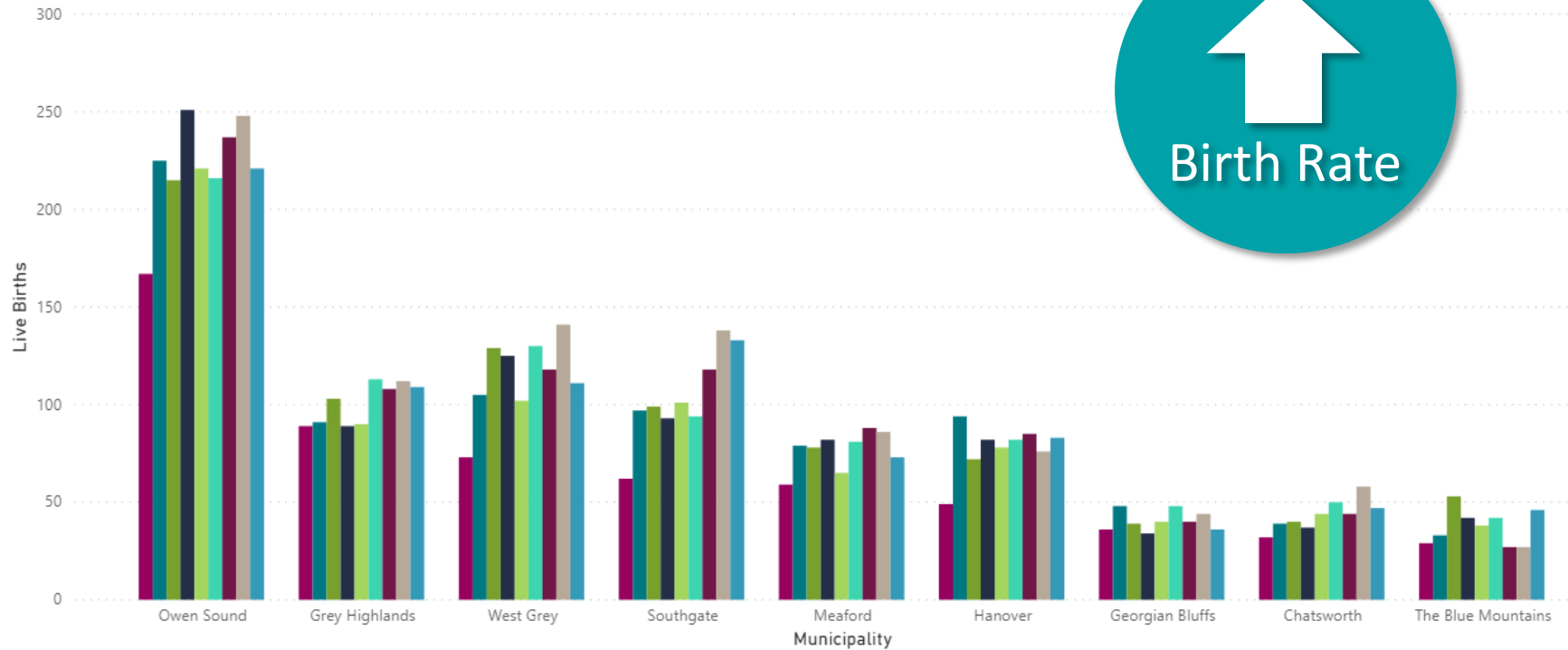

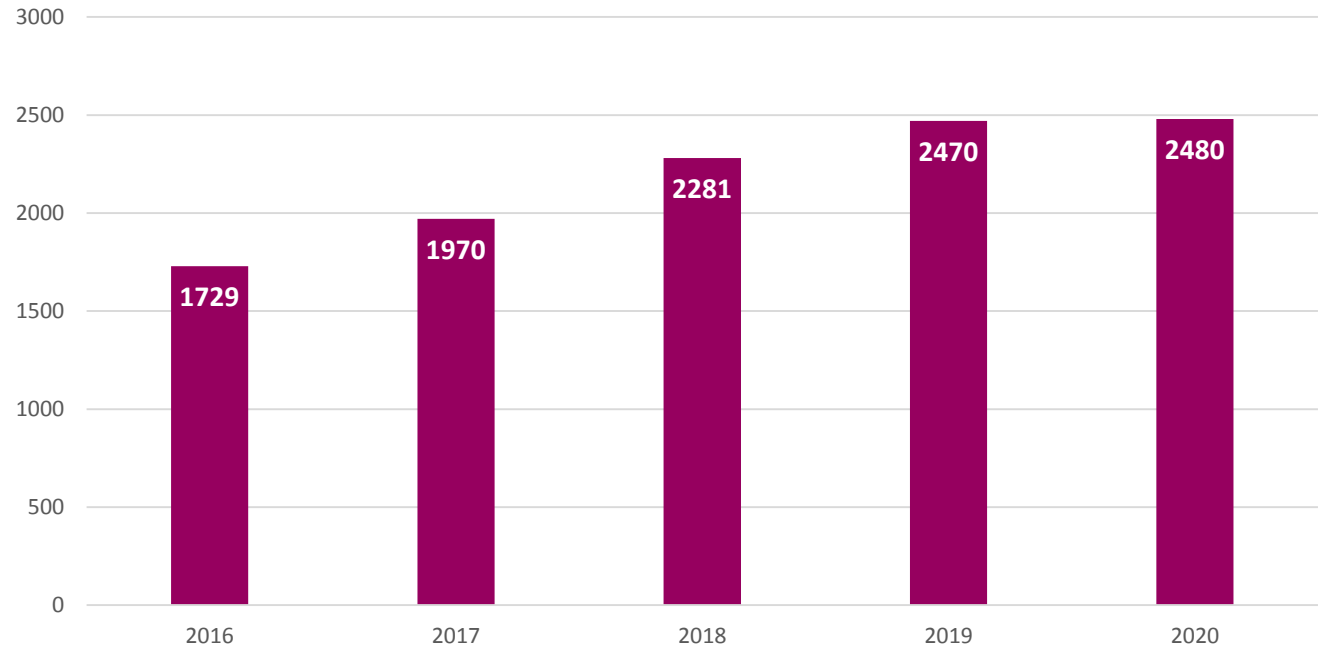

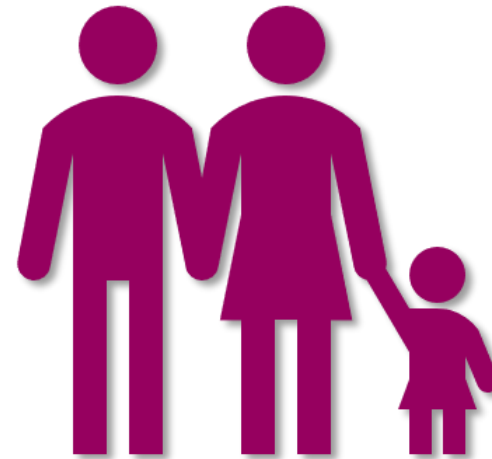
