

Grey County Population Change, 2016-2021





Grey County Total Dwellings Vs. Usual Residents, 2016-2021


• Total private dwellings percentage change, 2016 to 2021 • Private dwellings occupied by usual residents percentage change, 2016 to 2021





Licensed Spaces by Year, 2016 - 2022








Licensed Capacity Vs. Operating Capacity By Age (Q3, 2021)






Child Care Centre Staffing, Q3, 2021














Grey County Youth Population, 2021


