- Four urban areas: Ayton, Durham, Elmwood and Neustadt.
- 13,000 people; however, a considerable amount of newcomers recently.
- Population has grown by almost 8% between 2016-2021.


## Schools in West Grey

## **Growth in West Grey**

- Two subdivisions are under construction in Durham.
- These Durham subdivisions will add over 440 homes to our community.
- There are additional subdivisions in the planning stage that will add 150 homes to Neustadt.





### Youth in West Grey

Over 20% of West Grey's population is under the age of 19
or - approximately 2,745 people.



#### What's happening now

- Information sharing through parent email and the PTA.

#### Youth programs - West Grey Public Library



- Kindergarten and grade one story time
- Class trips to the library
- Children's librarian promotes the TD Summer Reading Club.
- Free library cards for students.

#### Youth programs - West Grey Fire Service

- Kindergarten and grade one programs.
- Grade eight students receive education regarding careers in fire services.
- Fire Prevention Week activities for students in grades three to six.
- Fire extinguisher training to grade seven and eight students.

- Award ceremonies
- School resource officer
- Participate in education programs
