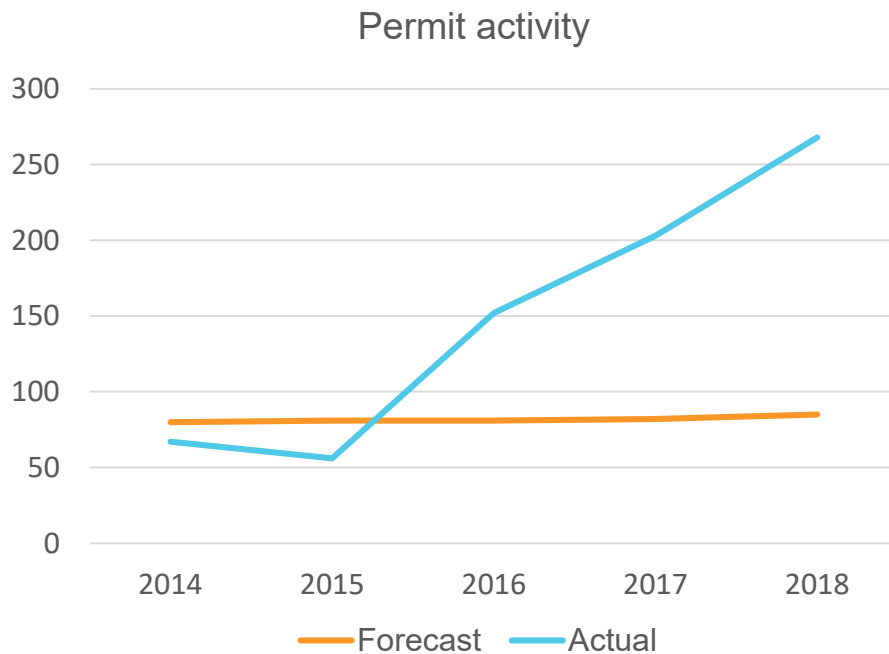

# Recent Activity



Permits for new dwellings are nearly 4.5x higher than in 2014.

2019 activity is slightly ahead of 2018 pace.

Saugeen Shores has accounted for 55% of all growth in Bruce County since 2001

This activity exceeds even our forecast growth from just 5 years ago

# Recent Activity

- 16 Nuclear suppliers have set up here since 2015
- 2 hotels expected this year
- More regional services are being considered in the area
