 - 3.1.2 demonstrate the board's commitment to ensuring equitable and inclusive learning and working environments for all members of the Bluewater District School Board community:
 - 3.1.3 be aligned with and support the principles and expectations of other Bluewater District School Board policies such as, but not limited to, BP 6303-D "Equity and Inclusive Education", BP 6820-D "Safe and Accepting Schools", and BP 7520-D "Human Rights", along with applicable legislation, such as the Ontario Human Rights Code.
